Cook/Baker	
Job Description	Prepares food such as soups, salads and general meals. Cooks may also oversee some menu planning and regulate stock control.
Education/Certification	A minimum of Grade 9 is required for entry level, with satisfactory Math and English grades. A camp cook diploma would be an asset. Aurora College offers camp catering training to prepare students for jobs in camp kitchens as helpers and preparers.
Experience	Camp cook experience would be an asset.
Skills	Needs good arithmetic and communication skills, including the ability to read and write in English; the ability to work alone or with a team.
Wage Range	\$14 to \$20 an hour
Transferability	Cooks and bakers are found in industry catering services, restaurants and other food services.
Food Preparer, Kitchen Help	No minimum education; needs high standard of personal hygiene, neat and tidy appearance, ability to follow oral and written instructions. Wage range: minimum wage to \$13 an hour.

Note: These job descriptions represent positions frequently found in large pipeline projects. Appropriate education and experience will play a determining role when selecting candidates. Some positions may require extensive natural gas related expertise. Salaries and wages are based on 2001 data and may change according to market conditions.
